Under this agreement for 2017

Magnetic Island State School will receive

\$71,580

This funding will be used to

- 80% of students achieving C or higher in English, mathematics and science in each year level.
- Increase Year 3 NAPLAN Upper 2 Bands in Reading from 40% in 2016, to 48% in 2017
- Increase Year 3 NAPLAN Upper 2 Bands in Writing from 47.6% in 2016, to 55% in 2017.
- Increase Year 3 NAPLAN Upper 2 Bands in Numeracy from 25% in 2015, to 33% in 2017.
- Increase the percentage of A level achievement in Year 1 to 3 in English from 17% in 2016 Semester 1, to 30% in 2017.
- Increase staff capability in Teaching With A Literacy Focus

Our initiatives include


- Continue to develop and build staff knowledge and capabilities in Reading and Writing demands within the Australian Curriculum.
